- 2.0 Regional Medical Director's Report -
 - 2.1 Medical Services Committee 9/10/21
 - a. Use of SGA by BLS in arrests Committee voted to incorporate into protocol as an AHMD option
 - b. Protocol 2.4 Behavioral, proposed p.o. med additions (Dr. Dyer) approved as medical director option
 - c. New Protocol: High Risk Infectious Disease adding as protocol retitled High Risk Infectious Disease.
 - d. Atropine dose per AHA update (Dr. Beltran) Change atropine dose to 1 mg every 3 to 5 min with max of 3 mg. Matches current ILCOR/AHA recommendations
 - e. Remove med appendix? Committee voted in favor to remove the medication appendix from the protocols.

3.0 Old Business

- 3.1 Ketamine in agitated delirium Approved for agitated delirium. Doses is up to 400mg of IM ketamine. There has been a request to have that dose increased to allow for patients who are heavier and may need increase of the max dose. Services are advised to contact medical control if more Ketamine is needed.
- 3.2 Any has any ideas for additions or changes to the protocols, please report to Dr. Old or the Region office to be included in the November 16, 2021 meeting.
